**CUP OF CONSULATE GENERAL OF POLAND IN LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA
APRIL 6-8, 2011 AT BRECKENRIDGE, COLORADO**

1. The games will be held in Breckenridge, CO from April 6-8, 2011. Trophies of the Consulate General of Poland in Los Angeles, CA will be awarded to the six fastest athletes. Slalom, Giant Slalom and Super G medals will be awarded through third place in each age group. Snowboarders will be awarded medals for Giant Slalom in the men and women categories. To enter, competitors must be Polish or of Polish origin. This can include friends of Polish families.

4. To enter, competitors must register by completing and signing the application and paying a registration fee to uisć.

5. Age of competitor counts by December 31st of the year preceding the competition. Competitors will be grouped by the following age groups:

Girls	6-8	9-11	12-14								
Boys	6-8	9-11	12-14								
Women	15-24	25-34	35-44	45+							
Men	15-19	20-24	25-29	30-34	35-39	40-44	45-49	50-54	55-59	60-64	65+

6. Each competitor is entitled to two runs per Slalom and Giant Slalom course. Snowboarders will compete only in the Giant Slalom event. The Super G event is not mandatory and does not count towards ranking. Also, general and family medals will be handed out through 3rd place in the men and women categories.

7. The correct course route is to navigate around each gate from start to finish with both skis.

8. Competitors for the The Family Cup must be related to one other. This can include the father or mother with their child, two competitors married to one other, or two siblings. For ranking, the score is counted four times the total sum of the runs: two Slalom and two Giant Slalom.

9. Anyone who is late to start will have to start at the end of their age group.

10. Time of course inspection included in the event program.

11. In the event of a conflict, immediately report to the Event Referees and pay the \$25 deposit. The deposit will be refunded if the complaint is justified, otherwise the deposit shall be forfeited.
